EMPLOYEE RETENTION

Hiring remote workers for your company has some fantastic benefits.

INCREASED PRODUCTIVITY

The myth that remote workers are lazy, jobless people is just that - a myth. Remote workers are often hardworking individuals who are also productive, productive professionals.

Employees working remotely can do their jobs without being under the same pressures that most people have to deal with. This allows them to work when they are at their best - during hours they find productive, without getting distracted with a noisy office environment.

The evidence of remote work's productivity boost has been documented in a 2020 Airtasker survey report. The report found that out of the 1,004 surveyed, 59% felt more motivated and productive when they worked remotely compared to the office. The survey suggests that remote workers take more breaks throughout the day, but they also spend more time than office-based employees on work tasks.

They are also less likely to get distracted at work than people who work in office environments.
